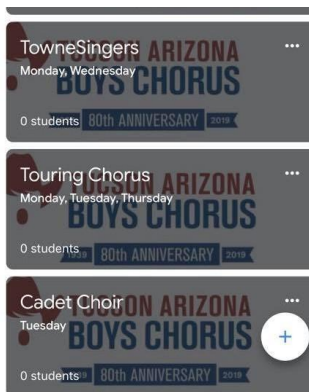
### Pops Concert CANCELLED
