We are thrilled to announce that, for the third time in its history, the Chorus has been invited to sing at the National Tree Lighting Ceremony in Washington, DC. The event will happen Thursday, December 5 and will be **televised on the REELZ and Ovation networks on Monday, December 9**. Check your local listings for exact times.

The boys first sang at the ceremony in 1963, less than one month after President Kennedy's assassination. The next appearance came in 1991 (picture shown). And now, as part of the 80th anniversary celebration, members of the Touring Chorus and Young Men's Ensemble will travel to the city for a whirlwind four-day tour. They will sing "Carol of the Bells" a cappella and "Most Wonderful Time of the Year" accompanied by the United States Marine Band.
