- Pops Concert: May 3, 2025, 3pm & 7:30pm, Catalina Foothills High School Auditorium. Additional rehearsal May 2. Tickets required.

## Volunteering & Fundraising

As a small organization, we cannot operate without volunteers and help from families. We do not require families to fundraise. We do ask for volunteer help throughout the year. We have three major fundraisers during the year: Musicale Regale (fall), Tree Lot (winter), and AZ Gives Day (spring).

Families are asked to work two shifts per chorister at our Tree Lot or pay \$75 per shift if you cannot volunteer. More detail will come via email in early November for Tree Lot shifts.

Musicale Regale is a fall gala with an auction component. We are always looking for items for the auction. If you can help with this, please let us know!

AZ Gives Day is the first week in April. You will receive information about spreading the word and fundraising goals in March.

### Other Information

We always welcome new choristers and encourage you to tell your son's friends, classmates, and teachers about the Chorus. Our biggest advocates are chorus families, and we appreciate any help you can offer to spread the word about the Boys Chorus. Choristers are welcome to bring a guest to a rehearsal or event, and will receive MIP tickets for doing so.

There are times in the year we ask you and your chorister to share information with others to help with recruitment, fundraising, or concert ticket sales. As a reward for helping, we give raffle tickets (MIP tickets) that are used throughout the year for prize drawings. We have a few drawings throughout the year and a grand prize drawing at the end of the season before the Pops Concert.

There are several family events throughout the year that we encourage you to attend with the whole family, not just your chorister. These include Family Fun Days, Boys Chorus Bowling, Splash Pad Parties, and others. You will receive information about these events via email and with a flyer sent home with your son. Most events are also posted on our Facebook page.

The Boys Chorus offers two different Day Camps. Wild West Rodeo Weekend is over the Rodeo break. Adventure a Day Camp is typically in June and runs for one week.

Jim Click Raffle Tickets are available for families to sell to offset tuition. Choristers will receive \$20 per Jim Click Raffle Ticket sold off the cost of their tuition. Raffle tickets are optional and will be available to sell mid-Spring to early December.
